- **Name of program-:** HU- Residency
- **Routes and Endorsements Offered:** Heritage University offers both alternate Route 3 and Route 4 teacher preparation program.

- **Delivery method:** In person with online components (videos & forum posts)
- **Delivery format [time]:** 6 week intensive summer institute (15 credits), 8 am – 5pm, Monday – Friday. Fall & Spring coursework scheduled Friday evening from 530-830 pm, and ALL DAY Saturday 8am-5pm (2 weekends a month).
- **Regions/School Districts Served:** Central Washington, Yakima Valley and Tricities. Courses offered at the main campus in Toppenish, WA as well as the Columbia Basin College in Pasco, WA.

- **Brief Description of Program:** Earn your degree in 11 months! During this program you are partnered with a core teacher in a classroom. This residency experience gives you a year of classroom experience as a mentored resident intern (student teacher). You will become a teacher by working side by side with peers and an experienced classroom instructor in a K-8 classroom two or three days each week. The other days during the week you will have the opportunity to be paid as a Para educator or substitute teacher. You will graduate with your Master in Teaching degree, WA state teaching certificate and an endorsement in special education, English language learners, or bilingual education. This program starts every June with prerequisite testing requirements.
