- o maintains records and/or prepares daily reports of student attendance, initiates discipline report procedures as appropriate, prepares student progress reports, and provides such reports to parents/guardians, as requested by the school principal;
- o participates in the planning and evaluation of the instructional program, and interprets the same to parents as necessary;
- o maintains a classroom atmosphere that fosters student learning;
- o professionally handles concerns or complaints;
- o properly and safely uses the materials and equipment provided by the district;
- o develops and maintains cordial working relationships with other district employees;
- o participates in continuing inservice opportunities and reviews publications and professional materials to keep informed of developments in the field of teaching and to improve personal performance;
- o accepts a reasonable amount of responsibilities beyond classroom activities, as requested by the school principal.

Qualifications: The teacher must:

- o have a valid and appropriate Washington State teaching certificate with the appropriate endorsement to qualify to teach the subject matter to which they are assigned;
- o have current immunizations;
- o have a demonstrated ability to communicate and work well with others.

Attributes: The teacher must demonstrate the following attributes:

- o a helpful, calm, friendly, and polite manner when interacting with students, parents and school staff;
- o the ability to work independently and cooperatively

- the ability to make reasoned decisions;
- appropriate discretion concerning students, staff, and confidential or privileged information.
