LOCKDOWN

RESPONSE TO: Definite threat of harm

- Close and lock external entrances
- Close and lock classroom doors
- Head count and collect
- Run/Barricade/Fight
- Monitor communications

SHELTER IN PLACE

RESPONSE TO: Chemical, biological or radioactive event

- Shelter in safe area within building
- Isolate your environment
- Head count and collect
- Monitor communications

SECURE AND TEACH

RESPONSE TO: Potential threat of harm

- Close and lock external entrances
- Head count and collect
- Continue to teach and move about inside as needed
- Monitor communications

EVACUATE

RESPONSE TO: Fire or other internal threat

- Immediately exit building and go to designated rally point (see map)
- If rally point is unsafe, move to safe area
- Building Safety Officer clear building
- Monitor Rave alerts
