This year, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we will not be giving away a pantry filler, instead we are providing the first 100 households


who register and participate in watching the videos, the opportunity to receive a \$ 50 Walmart gift card courtesy of Heritage Enactus.

Gift cards are limited to the first 100 participants who register through our link and provide valid information and address, in order for delivery of the gift card. Eligibility is a first come first serve basis.


