MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- 1. M.A. or M.S. and M.F.A. from a regionally accredited university with specialized training in the desired field; Doctorate desired.
- 2. Successful experience in the area of expertise;
- 3. Current certificates/licenses in the specific discipline(s) to be taught (if any).
- 4. Ability, or willingness to learn how, to use technology in teaching and assessment (internet, My Heritage, etc.)

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Interested applicants are invited to submit the application package containing the following items:

- [] Completed Application
- [] Resume/Curriculum Vitae: Provide a current résumé that includes personal and biographical information, scholarly work (presentations, publications) service, honors, residence and business addresses and telephone numbers, e-mail address, educational background, professional experiences, and evidence of teaching effectiveness and other information you believe will be helpful in the assessment of your candidacy.
- [] Official Transcript: Order an official transcript showing your highest degree and have it mailed or emailed to the Office of Human Resources.
