PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines for the implementation of curriculum changes. This policy ensures that Heritage University Nursing Department (HUND) program curricula are in compliance with and approved by accrediting bodies and are consistent with the Heritage University mission.

AUDIENCE

This policy applies to all HUND students, instructors, and staff.

PLAN

The curricula are reviewed annually by the Nursing Department Curriculum Committee in accordance with the Nursing Department Bylaws. Any individual, group, or committee may propose changes to the curriculum.

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

- 1) Each NURS course will be evaluated by the Curriculum Committee at least once every 3 years (see Curriculum Committee Course Review Calendar, and Curriculum Committee Course Review Checklist).
- 2) Proposed curricular revisions must be submitted to the Curriculum Committee in writing and include:
 - a. A detailed description of the proposed curriculum change.
 - b. Rationale for the proposed curriculum change.
- 3) Proposed curricular changes will be reviewed by the Curriculum Committee.
- 4) The Curriculum Committee will present any committee-recommended proposed curriculum changes to the Nursing Department Faculty Assembly.
- 5) Approved curriculum changes that are not substantive will be adopted by the Nursing Department Faculty Assembly.
- 6) Approved curriculum changes that are substantive will be submitted to the Heritage University Curriculum Committee, and then to the appropriate accrediting body for approval. Per WAC 246-840-554 (abbreviated below):
 - a. Substantive changes include:

- i. Changes in legal status, control, ownership, or resources of the institution
 - ii. Faculty numbers below the required staff for clinical or clinical simulation sections
 - iii. Changes in faculty composition when their expertise or experiences are not adequate to teach those areas of nursing
 - iv. Changes in the number of students admitted requiring one or more additional clinical or practice groups, or changing the required faculty to student ratios of 1:10 for prelicensure programs
 - v. Major curriculum revision or changes in the length of the program.
 - b. Major curriculum revisions include:
 - i. Changes in curricular delivery method [in-person, remote, hybrid, asynchronous]
 - ii. Changes in nursing model or conceptual framework
 - iii. Changes in curriculum meaning or direction of the curriculum such as philosophy, program goals, program terminal objectives, course objectives and descriptions
 - iv. Changes in total program credits
 - v. Addition or deletion of a satellite or extended campus.
 - c. The following changes do not require commission approval:
 - i. Movement of content from one course to another; or
 - ii. Formatting changes in syllabi.
- 7) The chair of the Curriculum Committee will consult with the Nursing Director and HU VP of Accreditation to determine:
 - a. the Washington Administrative Code rules and regulations regarding reporting to the Washington State Board of Nursing (WABON) revision submission; and
 - b. the procedure for submitting curriculum changes to national accreditation agencies.
- 8) Approved changes will be implemented.
- 9) Any curriculum changes made that affect current students must be provided to the students in writing as a supplement to their student
