The MSW Program does not yet have data for the Generalist Practice level because the program launched its inaugural cohort with Advanced Standing students, who complete their studies in the first year. The 2025-2026 school year marks the first year we have accepted students into the Generalist Practice track, which requires a two-year completion. As we are currently in the first year of the program's full two-year cycle, data for the Generalist Practice level will not be available until the first cohort progresses into and completes its second year. Data from this cohort will be reviewed during the Summer of 2026, and a progress report can be provided if needed.
