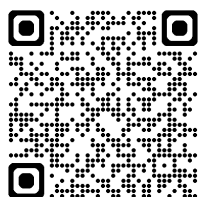

The program is structured so that it includes the content specifications established by the Institute of Management Accountants (IMA) for testing to become a Certified Management Accountant (CMA). Professionals with this credential specialize in corporate accounting where they represent the interests of the business. Students are encouraged to take the CMA exam before graduating. Certified Public Accountants (CPA) have a broader knowledge in accounting practices and represent the public interest. You and your advisor can adjust your academic plan to meet the 150 credit hour rule that is required to test for this certification.
